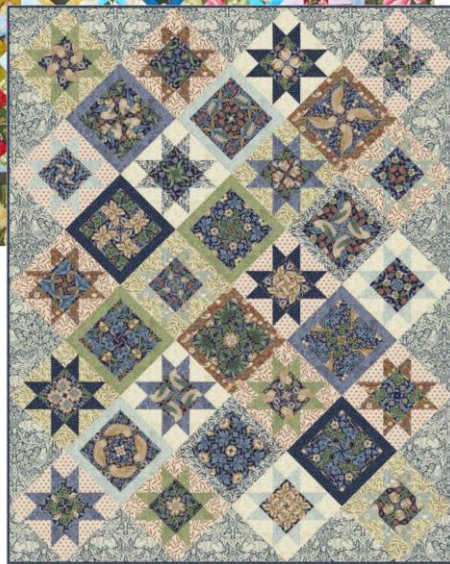

Class Description

Are you intrigued by the look of kaleidoscope blocks? Do you love using lots of fabrics in your quilts? This quilt is comprised of easy four-patch kaleidoscope squares surrounded by framing strips and star points. You will be amazed at the variety of blocks created by a feature fabric and coordinating prints. And you have so many options...floral prints, novelty, kids' prints, etc.

Class Supply List

- **Kensington Kaleidoscope pattern. May be purchased at discounted price of \$7.50 in class.**
- Fabric – Fabric requirements are shown in the table below. The feature fabric and a few of the light and medium/dark fat quarters are needed for class. You may prefer to purchase the additional fat quarters after class when you have become more acquainted with the feature fabric colors. Marilyn will have some feature print yardage available for sale at the workshop so if you aren't sure about your feature fabric choice you can purchase something at the workshop. Hints on selecting fabric: Avoid fabrics with large areas of blank space. Fabrics work best if there is activity throughout the fabric so that when we cut the fabric into small squares some part of the design will show in each square. Recommend fabric repeat of at least 6". There is more variety and therefore more interesting blocks if you choose a fabric with a larger repeat. If the same small design repeats itself across the entire fabric you won't get as much variety in your blocks but the star points and block frame fabrics help add variety to the blocks.
- Rotary mat (the larger the better!), cutter, and rulers (recommend large 6" x 24" ruler, medium ruler such as 4" x 14", and a smaller ruler such as 6" x 6")
- Pins – flower head pins in addition to regular pins are needed. The flower head pins are very helpful during preparation and cutting of the feature fabric.
- Basic sewing supplies (scissors, thread, seam ripper, etc.)
- Pencil or mechanical pencil for drawing lines on fabric
