

## Marilyn Foreman Triple Twister Class Cutting Directions

**Purchase fabric as shown on the Supply List for the Runner (R) or Small Throw (S).**

**For regular fabric versions, cut the pinwheel fabric into 5” squares and the background fabric into 3” strips as shown below.**

**For the 4-Patch Kaleidoscope version runner, only cut the FQ into 5” squares and the background yardage into 3” strips as shown below. We will cut the medium/large scale print into 4-patch kaleidoscopes during class.**

### Fabric for Pinwheels:

	<b>Runner (R)</b>	<b>Small Throw/ Baby (S)</b>
<b>Total 5” squares needed</b>	27	108

**If Using Charm Packs (5” squares):** Collect total number of squares shown in table above.

**If Using Layer Cakes (10” squares):** Sub-cut each 10” square into (4) 5” squares to yield number shown in table above.

### **If Using Fat Quarters (FQ):**

Cut each FQ crosswise width of fabric (WOF) into (3) 5” strips and sub-cut each 5” strip into (4) 5” squares. Each FQ yields twelve 5” squares.

### **If Using Yardage:**

Cut yardage crosswise 42+” width of fabric (WOF) into 4(R), or 14(S) 5” strips.

Sub-cut the 5” strips into eight 5” squares each to yield number of squares shown in table above for your size.

### Background Fabric for Block Frames:

**If Using Fat Quarters:** One FQ yields frames for one block

Cut each FQ crosswise WOF into (4) 3” strips.

Sub-cut the strips into (2) 3” x 14” rectangles and (2) 3” x 19” rectangles.

### **If Using Yardage:**

Cut crosswise 42+” width of fabric (WOF) into 6(R), or 24(S) 3” strips.

Sub-cut the 3” strips into 6(R), or 24 (S), 3” x 14” rectangles and 6(R), or 24 (S) 3” x 19” rectangles.

Note: If using two different fabrics for background, cut half of the strips and rectangles from each fabric.
