

Kensington Kaleidoscope Workshop with Marilyn Foreman Cutting Directions

No cutting is required before class, however, if you wish to do some pre-cutting, please **DO NOT** cut the feature fabric since we will do this together in class.

You may cut some of the **Star Points/Block Frames** and **Star Background** fabrics following the instructions below for your quilt size if you've already purchased fabrics following the **Supply List**. **Only one of the star point and background fabrics will be used during class so feel free to just cut one of each or do it during class.**

If you haven't purchased feature print fabric in advance and plan to purchase yardage from Marilyn in class, please email Marilyn at Marilyn@QuiltMoments.com to let her know so she will bring enough fabric.

Size of quilts are reference below as follows:

TW=Twin

B = Baby/Small

TH=Throw

Q=Queen

Star Points and Block Frames – at least 10 FQs medium/dark prints for TW (4+ FQs B, 7+ FQs TH, 17+ FQs Q)

- 1) Cut 2 strips – 2-7/8" x 21" crosswise width of each fat quarter. From each strip cut (6) 2-7/8" squares, yielding twelve 2-7/8" squares from each fabric.
- 2) Cut 4 strips – 1-1/2" x 21" crosswise width of each fat quarter. From each strip cut one piece 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" and one piece 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" yielding four pieces of each size.
- 3) Need total of 30 TW (12 B, 20 TH, 56 Q) sets of 4 matching 2-7/8" squares, and 20 TW (6 B, 12 TH, 42 Q) sets of matching 1-1/2" strips: 2 – 6-1/2" long and 2 – 8-1/2" long

Star Backgrounds– at least 5 FQs light prints for TW (2+ FQs B, 4+ FQs TH, 10+ FQ Q)

- 1) Cut 3 strips – 5-1/4" x 21" crosswise width of each fat quarter. From each strip cut (2) 5-1/4" squares and (8) 2-1/2" squares yielding (6) 5-1/4" squares and (24) 2-1/2" squares of each fabric.
- 2) Need total of (30) 5-1/4" squares TW (12 B, 20 TH, 56 Q) and 30 sets TW (12 B, 20 TH, 56 Q) of 4 matching 2-1/2" squares.
